- All entry forms and entry fees due June 21<sup>st</sup> at 12:00pm.
- Entry forms can be emailed to [macgregorfair@hotmail.com](mailto:macgregorfair@hotmail.com), mailed to North Norfolk and District Ag Society Box 413 MacGregor, MB or dropped off at the Heartland Recreation Office
- Articles can be dropped off at the Heartland Office from June 1 – June 20<sup>th</sup>. After that date they can be dropped off at Stride Centre from between **9:00 am and 12:00pm** Friday June 21, 2019. And must remain at the show until **4:00pm** Saturday June 23, 2018
- Judging will take place after 12:00pm June 21, 2019, articles will not be accepted once judging begins.
- Directors are not responsible for any articles left.
- All entries must be the work of, or produced by, the Exhibitor
- Prizes are: 1<sup>st</sup> - \$10, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$6, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$4 **unless otherwise stated**
- Entry Fees are \$1.00/entry and a membership fee of \$5.00/exhibitor
- Judges decision will be final
- All baking to be in a plastic bag. Use zip lock bags or fasten bags with wire tie. No saran wrap.
- The right to alter, add or cancel any class/section is reserved by the Directors of the North Norfolk and District Ag Society whose decision will be final
- Photography entries must be printed on good quality photo paper and/or mounted on card stock
- Judging will take place on Friday after 12:00pm
- Age as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of current calendar year
- In case of no competition, the judge will only give a first prize if work is worthy

**4-H Individual Member**

Must be a 4-H member to enter. Scoring: General appearance 25%, Power to attract and hold attention 25%, Message 40%, Quality of materials 15%

**Section 22      Class #**

- 1      A collection of at least 5 photographs promoting 4-H (must be mounted and labeled), presenting a collection so it depicts a story
- 2      A poster on safety, on the farm or in the home
- 3      A poster promoting a farm animal (must include information on nutritional benefits)
- 4      A poster promoting 4-H projects other than farm animals with nutritional benefits
- 5      4-H project completed in current year by exhibitor
- 6      4-H Club project book
- 7      A scrapbook page from current club year
- 8      Essay "What 4-H has meant for me" or "What 4-H has done for me" (minimum of 500 words)
- 9      Photography, your pet/animal, 1 picture
- 10     Photography, club meeting/activity, 1 picture
