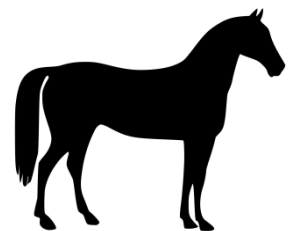

General Rules and Regulations

1. All exhibitors must be members of the North Norfolk Agricultural Society. Membership fee of \$5.00 must accompany all entries.
2. All entries should be made in advance to the Secretary only. All entries to be in to Secretary one week prior to the fair.
3. All exhibits must be the bonafide property of the exhibitors for at least 30 days and Agricultural Products must be grown by the exhibitors in that current year.
4. No person will be allowed to interfere with the judges in the discharge of their duties, exhibitors doing so will forfeit their right to any premium to which they might otherwise be entitled. Any protests must be made in writing to the Secretary before the close of the exhibition.
5. The Directors will not be responsible for any articles, injures, lost or stolen, but will render assistance on protecting and recovering same.
6. If quality of article does not warrant first prize, even though there may not be any competition, the judges shall award only the prize the exhibit warrants.
7. No prize money will be paid until the exhibitors' obligations are complete.
8. No exhibits, displays, sales or lotteries of any type will be permitted on the grounds or in the vicinity of the same without the permission of the directors.
9. The directors reserve the right to limit the total prize lists to an amount equal to the net receipts after payment of all expenses. In the event of the net receipts after payment of all expenses being insufficient to permit prize list being paid each prize will be reduced pro rata accordingly, and all entries are received are on this distinct understanding.
10. All exhibitors must appear in the ring when their class is called. All exhibitors must be properly attired.
11. A "junior" will be defined as anyone who has not attained their 18th birthday as of January 1st of the current year.
12. No entry fee refund in the event of scratches. **STRICTLY ADHERED TO!!!**
13. All trailers to be parked in designated area.
14. All competitors must encourage SAFETY in and around livestock!!!

Livestock

1. Entries must be in to Secretary one week prior to fair. Entries are 10% of the first placing for that particular class.
2. Horses shown in halter sections may be combined and shown as a team.
3. Brood mares must be accompanied by their foals.
4. Draft, Agricultural, General-Purpose and Farm Chuck teams are shown in harness and wagons.
5. Ages of animals will date from January 1st of current year.
6. All animals must be securely tied, including foals, and led into the ring to be judged.
7. All owners are responsible for damages/injuries caused by animals in their care & must be covered by liability insurance.
8. The mistreatment of animals will not be tolerated.

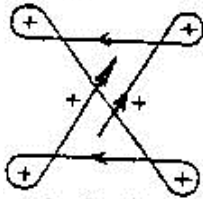
Rules and Description of Fun Classes

Flag Race: Two barrels are at one end of the arena, one on each side. Ride down to the first one, pick up a flag out of the bucket on the barrel, ride to the next barrel, put the flag in the bucket, ride back to the finish. Time penalties for missed buckets or knocked over barrels. and if you go on the inside of the barrels you are disqualified.

Egg and Spoon Race: The participants each get an egg (or other object) on a spoon and will be asked to walk, jog and lope – although other maneuvers may be added. The last person with an egg wins.

Ride and Race: This is a relay between two teams (which we will create on fair day once we have all the entries). The first player runs down the arena on foot with their horse once they get to the barrel at the far end of the arena, they mount their horse and ride back to the other end, once passed the marker, the next player rides down to the end of the arena and to the barrel, and then dismounts and runs back, this keeps alternating until all team members have gone. The first team to have all their members cross the finish line wins.

Cloverleaf: Start in the centre, 4 turns, two to the right and two to the left.



Speedball: Rider rides down to the pylon, and around the pylon and as you go around the pylon drop the golf ball in the top of the pylon. If you miss getting the golf ball into the pylon or knock over the pylon you are disqualified.
