Applications and supporting documents must be received no later than May 31, 2025 in order to be considered by the Scholarship Committee. Winner will be announced at the MCI graduation. We will make a special presentation at the MacGregor Fair on June 28, 2025. Funds will be provided in two equal amounts: initial \$500 at time of graduation, and second \$500 at the proof of registration of 2<sup>nd</sup> semester. If in an apprentice program, 2<sup>nd</sup> payment will be at the completion of level 1.

#### Scholarship criteria:

#### **Eligibility:**

- 1. Must currently be a permanent residence in our membership area
- 2. Applicants must provide a current transcript of marks
- 3. Incomplete or inaccurate applications will not be considered
- 4. Applicants must provide proof of their volunteer service see attached
- 5. The Selection Committee may choose not to give the award if no suitable applicant is found.
- 6. Applications are to be submitted on or before May 31, 2025

### Selection Criteria:

The applications will be assessed based on the following criteria:

- Either a typed 500-word essay or a 4-5 minute video submission, discussing "What Agriculture in Your Community Means to You."
- A copy of your transcript
- A list of your school and signed proof of your community involvement
